

MUS 101 – Fall 2008 Concert Attendance Requirement

You are required to attend **five** concerts this semester. On the website at

you will find a list of all approved concerts given on the WCU campus.

To receive credit for attending these concerts you **must** scan your CATcard when entering and exiting the concert. There will be an attendant at the door to help you – if you do not scan your card **before** the start of the concert **AND** at the **end** of the concert you will not receive attendance credit. No credit will be given for late arrivals or early departures, remember.....

YOU MUST ATTEND THE ENTIRE CONCERT IN ORDER TO RECEIVE CREDIT FOR ATTENDANCE.

In the event that you go to a concert where there is not a monitor scanning CATcards, you must locate a faculty member or a performer present and have them sign your program. Turn the program in to me, with your name on it, at the next class.

I will give attendance credit if you choose to go to a classically oriented concert off-campus, but please have me approve it before you go. You will need to turn in a program and a ticket stub for these events.

CONCERT ETTIQUETTE

You are expected to be a courteous and aware audience member. You will be given a chance to hear some extremely talented musicians over the course of the semester – show them the respect they deserve for all the hard work they have put into their art.

There will be **no**: sleeping, wearing of hats, feet on the chair, talking, or other inappropriate behavior. If I observe such behavior or have it reported to me by other faculty members you will not receive credit for having attended the concert.
