Recess Activities

Purpose of the Project:

The course instructor will teach a lesson on a particular skill theme and the student will support the lesson with an appropriate children's game/activity. The student must be ready to teach a game with that skill to the class on the day that their skill is covered by the course instructor.

Procedures:

1. Select a game/activity from one of the resources listed below.
2. Prepare the lesson on the game/activity. Be sure to use include the types of skill themes and movement concepts that will be utilized in the activity.
3. Arrange for all necessary equipment ahead of time.
4. Practice the activity (if possible) at least once before you present it to the class.
5. Submit a general lesson plan (format of your choice). Be sure to identify skill themes and movement concepts learned in this class.

Evaluation:

The project is worth 10% of the final grade.

Note: My observation will consist of the general presentation of the activity.
