TISSUE PLASMINOGEN ACTIVATOR TPA, Alteplase

PHARMACOLOGIC CLASSIFICATION:

- -enzyme
- -endogenous substance manufactured synthetically

THERAPEUTIC CLASSIFICATION:

-thrombolytic

MECHANISM OF ACTION:

-directly catalyzes the conversion of plasminogen to plasmin

EFFECT:

-dissolves thrombi (clots) associated with acute MI

INDICATIONS:

- -treatment of acute MI
- -treatment of CVA

DOSAGE:

- -15 mg over 2 minutes
- -0.75 mg/kg over 30 minutes (not to exceed 50 mg)
- -0.5 mg/kg over 60 minutes (not to exceed 35 mg)

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

- -surgery within last 2 months
- -history of CVA within the past 6 months
- -history of bleeding disorder
- -severe hypertension
- -prolonged CPR chest compressions

SIDE EFFECTS:

- -intracranial and GI bleeding
- -headache
- -arrhythmias
- -nausea/vomiting

COMMENTS:

- -use cautiously in patients over the age of 75
- -if possible have a second IV line established
