50% DEXTROSE (DEX-trohs) D₅₀, D₅₀W

PHARMACOLOGIC CLASSIFICATION:

-carbohydrate

THERAPEUTIC CLASSIFICATION:

-hyperglycemic

MECHANISM OF ACTION:

-rapidly increases circulating blood sugar levels

INDICATIONS:

- -suspected or known hypoglycemia
- -coma of unknown origin
- -altered LOC

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

- -intracranial hemorrhage
- -known CVA

SIDE EFFECTS:

- -may cause severe neurologic symptoms in alcoholics
- -may aggravate hypertension and CHF
- -may cause tissue necrosis at the site if IV infiltrates

DOSAGE:

-25 grams slow IV push

SPECIAL INFORMATION:

- -consider administration of Thiamine before D50, especially in known alcoholics, in order to avoid possible neurological consequences associated with Wernicke's encephalopathy (associated with thiamine deficiency)
- -obtain blood glucose level, if possible, before administration
