Purpose of the Research Proposal Establish the context for your study and demonstrate a need for it Show that your study will meet the need, using the methods your propose Give assurances that your study will not harm its subjects Serve as a "game plan" for conducting your study Justify the funding required to conduct the study

Components of the Proposal Introduction Literature Review Methods Analysis Plan Budget HSCC 470 Research Proposal

Introduction Delineate the problem, question, or theory to be tested Discuss (briefly) the most relevant work done on the subject Present the need for further work State the purpose of the study

Literature Review • Describe the problem or question you seek to solve • Describe previous work • Describe gaps and shortcomings in previous work
