

About Ms. Wilhelm


- She is originally from Salisbury, North Carolina.

It's past the dam (half mile past the bridge over the dam). On left is a lakeside park with more parking and a beautiful view of Lake Glenville. The street address is 1960 Pine Creek Road, Cullowhee. GPS coordinates 35.198062, 83.150715. It's about 68 miles from downtown Asheville and eight miles to Cashiers. Cullowhee and Western Carolina University is 18 miles north.
