Web 2.0 Teaching Tool Creation and Profile Assignment

Note: This tool needs your expertise to be excellent. Be sure to edit these instructions for clarity and relevance!

Assignment directions

In this assignment, you will create a teaching tool using one of three Web 2.0 platforms: Padlet, Kahoot, or edPuzzle. After setting up a free teacher account, you will design an activity for students in your current internship placement. Then, you will write a detailed profile of the tool explaining what it is and how it can be used in teaching.

Here are the steps:

- 1. Choose one tool: Padlet, Kahoot, or edPuzzle.
- 2. Create a free teacher account using your class email or personal email.
- 3. Design an activity for your internship students:
 - o Padlet: create a board.
 - o Kahoot: create a quiz or game.
 - o edPuzzle: create a video with embedded questions.
- 4. Make sure your activity is accessible to your instructor for grading:
 - o For edPuzzle, set it to public.
 - For Padlet, set it to secret but not password protected.
- 5. Copy the clickable link to your activity and add it to the designated webpage (Web 2.0 #1).
- 6. Write a profile of the tool on the same page, including:
 - One paragraph (3–4 sentences) describing the tool with concrete details and examples.
 - Three robust paragraphs explaining how the tool can be used in your classroom, including:
 - At least 3–4 specific uses for teaching and learning or teacher work.
 - One use related to social-emotional learning.

- One use tied to a curriculum standard relevant to your students, including a lesson idea.
- 7. Submit the link to your published webpage to show your assignment is complete and ready for grading.

Remember, your writing must be in your own words and voice. Do not use Al-generated text.
